Whilst being a totally unique organisation with only two fulltime officers the 216 year old society manages to provide additional safety cover at major international and local events mainly all based around the River Clyde and Glasgow but sometimes also providing safety cover for events up river as far as Motherwell and downstream to Greenock also assisting at events on other local waterways.

The Society has links with all rowing clubs within Scotland, numerous other home countries based clubs and international clubs, both the Amateur Rowing Association and the Scottish Amateur Rowing Association along with the Scottish Canoe Association and numerous canoe clubs, the Scottish Dragon Boat Association, and various lifesaving clubs.
